Thank you for your participation on today's call. If you have not already sent us your top 3 topics for ETNNA, please email your choices to rachael@resource-solutions.org.

The intention is for us to create a consensus based Best Practices paper on one or more of these topics. The first topic will be on the **uniform treatment of environmental attributes across tracking systems**. Your input on the list below will help us determine ETNNA's priorities over the next year.

As a reminder, the topics we are considering for the coming year are:

1. **Energy Efficiency:** How should energy efficiency (or white certificates) be tracked within the electricity tracking systems?
2. **Coordination between electricity and emissions tracking:** How carbon regulation is intersecting with electricity tracking systems and how should the electricity tracking systems be coordinating with emissions tracking registries?
3. **Verification of generation characteristics:** What standards should be put in place for verification of generation characteristics?
4. **Null power:** How should null power be treated?
5. **Distributed generation:** How do we consistently treat and verify distributed generation?
6. **Import/export agreements and capabilities:** How do we develop national import/export agreements and capabilities between tracking systems?
7. **Self-reporting standards:** What standards should be developed for self-reporting information to tracking systems?

We will be having a repeat of our presentation on March 25th at 11:00 am (Pacific) for interested parties that were unable to attend today's meeting. Because of today's technical difficulties, we will be using different service providers for our call on March 25th, and we will send out details soon for this meeting.
